### Kindergarten Year End Celebration

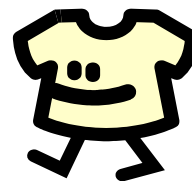

**2009-2010 School Year Coupon Books** - For those who have selected the 12-month payment plan, you should have received our mailing which explained the collection procedure for next year. You must use a COUPON and the REMITTANCE ENVELOPE provided to mail monthly tuition and daycare payments. Please notify the Finance Office if you did not receive the mailing.

**IMPORTANT:** Please do not discard your coupon book, even if you have elected to make tuition payments by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT).

**JUST A REMINDER:** Payments for tuition and/or daycare cannot be accepted in any school office. Please use the remittance envelopes provided.

**2009-2010 School Year Coupon Books** will be mailed in June, for those selecting the 10-month payment plan. Consider making your payments by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) and avoid late charges. A form will be included with your new coupon book materials.

**RECEIPT REQUEST** - We will be glad to provide a receipt for tuition and/or extended care for those that need it for employer reimbursement and/or tax purposes. You may call or E-mail the Finance Office **monthly** and **allow five days for your request to be answered.**

**Water Safety**

To ensure that your children are safe, never leave them unsupervised around water. Here are some tips to keep your child safe around the water this spring and summer:

- Teach your child to swim, but remember that younger children shouldn't be left unsupervised around water even if they know how to swim.
- Always wear a US Coast Guard approved life jacket when on a lake, river or ocean while boating, water skiing, jet skiing or tubing.
- Warn your children about playing in canals or other fast moving water.
- Do not let your child play around any water (lake, pool, ocean, etc.) without adult supervision (even if he is a good swimmer).
- Don't allow running or rough play around the water.
- Childproof your swimming pool with a fence around your backyard and a fence (at least 4 feet high) around the pool, with a self-closing, self-latching gate. Also consider having a phone poolside and learning CPR in case of emergencies.
