

A MESSAGE FROM THE
HEAD OF SCHOOL



Dear FCS Families,

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we transition all K-8 instruction to e-learning. Today, we finalized plans for our transition and we are scheduled to begin instruction at 9 AM on Wednesday morning. The expectations for our e-learning program have been updated and are located in the "FCS E-Learning Expectations - Families" guidelines (please see attached). Please take the time to review this information prior to Wednesday.

Tomorrow, our classrooms will be open from 1 to 3 PM to allow parents a window in which to pick up student materials and/or check out digital devices. At elementary, devices will be checked out at each classroom. 5th grade devices will also be available at each classroom while 6th grade parents may check out devices on the Plaza outside the Rose Drive Worship Center. To reduce the number of individuals on campus and to avoid congregating, we ask that each family send one family member to retrieve items. If you have children who need to wait in your car, we'll have personnel in all parking lots to help supervise.

Accelerated Reader location restrictions have been removed and students will be able to take quizzes from home beginning on Wednesday. Second through eighth grade students may use their User Name and Password at the following link:
